Superlite MDF is 1/3 lighter in weight than regular MDF but maintains excellent strength quality, surface smoothness and stability. The surface can be painted to achieve a high quality finish and provides a uniform substrate for overlaying. Features a lighter, consistent colour tone than other MDF's, making it an ideal substrate for cold laminating (which is recommended over hot laminating) with natural wood veneers, vinyls, printed papers, foils and melamine papers. The lighter weight makes it easier to work, with consequent increased efficiency.

Superlite MDF machines great! It can be worked easily with standard wood working machinery. For the good finish on the edges that Superlite MDF's homogenous nature provides, tungsten carbide cutters and saws are recommended. The reduction in density ensures that machine tools will last many times longer and so reduces down time. Tungsten carbide cutters and saws are recommended. Available in your choice of 3/4", 1/2", 5/8" or 1" thicknesses.

TO ENSURE PRODUCT PERFORMANCE

For best results Superlite MDF should be used for interior applications only. It should not be exposed to water or high humidity situations (saunas or shower cabinets) and should be kept clear of nearby heat sources such as solid fuel heaters and free standing fireplaces.
